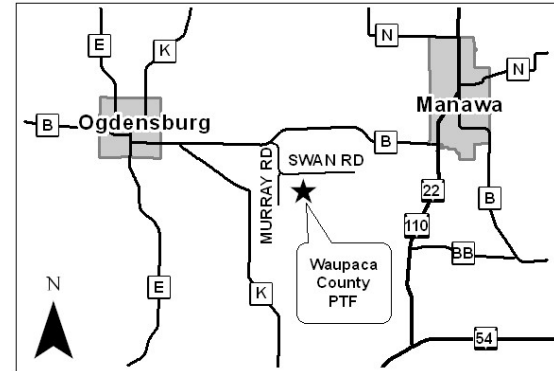

Mattresses & Box Springs \$15.00 each

NO asbestos-containing material accepted at Facility.

Brush-Trees

\$20.00 ton NO stumps

\$5.00 minimum charge (up to 500 lbs.)

Leaves-Grass-Pine Needles

No charge

Appliances

Freon units - \$15.00

Refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, air conditioners

Non-Freon units - \$10.00

Latex Paint Hardener

Cost: \$4.00 per bag

Solidifies approx. 2/3 gallon of latex paint in 15 minutes. Solidified paint can be disposed of in trash.

Recyclables (4 sorts required)

1. Green/brown glass bottles

- food or beverage only

2. Clear glass bottles

- food or beverage only



NO window glass, light bulbs, mirrors, dish-ware, or ceramics

3. Plastic bottles & containers

- Food, drink, household products, etc.
- Dairy, produce, bakery deli



NO 5 gal. pails, plastic bags, plant pots, motor oil bottles, laundry baskets

Aluminum bottles & cans

Empty aerosol cans

Steel, tin, bi-metal cans



4. Newspaper, magazines, mixed paper, cardboard, cereal, & other box board



NO food-contaminated paper, tissue paper, or wax coated cardboard
